

COVID Measures from 19th July 2021

Following the Prime Minister's recent announcement on the relaxation of Covid restrictions, please note the arrangements below which will apply at the Club from Monday 19th July. They will be kept under constant review in light of the planned lifting of self-isolation requirements on 16th August and any changes in policy which might emerge before then.

It goes without saying that the safety of our staff, members and guests is our primary concern as we move towards an end to all restrictions. We know members will continue to take personal responsibility and show consideration for others at what is a critical point in the journey through this pandemic.

Generally

There will no longer be a requirement to scan the QR code on entering the Club.
The one metre plus social distancing rule is abolished.
Staff will continue to carry out lateral flow tests on a twice-weekly basis.

Inside the Clubhouse

Staff and Members should feel free to wear a mask if they wish, but this will no longer be a requirement.

We will maintain our current table layout and increased ventilation for the time being.
The Rule of 6 will continue inside the Clubhouse

Table service for both food and drink will continue.

Outside

Staff/Members may wear masks if they wish, but there is no requirement

The Rule of six will no longer apply on the Terrace.

Table service for both food and drink will continue.
